IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER: Dogs must have earned a TD to enter the
 Variable Surface Test.

USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM and
 write "VST" in the Obedience Trail Class space. Faxed, telephoned,
 unsigned, conditional, or incomplete entries cannot be accepted.
 Entries not on an official AKC Entry form and photocopies of forms
 without the agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official
 AKC entry form are not accepted.

DRAW FOR ENTRIES: If entries received exceed the test limit of 7
 dogs, a public drawing will be held Wednesday, April 7, 2010, at 6:00
 p.m. at Pekoe Sip House, 1225 Alpine Avenue, Boulder, Colorado.
 Preference for the first two tracks drawn will be given to DFTA test
 workers who submit a DFTA issued worker certification with their
 entry form. Visit the DFTA website for details of the test worker
 preference process. An attempt to notify entrants will be made by the
 secretary within 48 hours of the draw. Long distance phone calls
 from exhibitors to the Trial Secretary will be returned collect.

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 (in US Dollars) (This includes the 50 cent AKC
 recording fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee.) Make all checks
 and money orders **payable to DFTA** and mail with entry to **Ms**
Martha Rosner, PO Box 17732, Boulder, Colorado 80308. Entries
 sent by OVERNIGHT DELIVERY must be marked "no signature
 required" and must be sent through the US Post Office The only
 address available for overnight delivery is a post office box.

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or if a
 dog is withdrawn from the test after the closing date, absent on the
 day of the test, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from
 competition by the test committee, unless an alternate exhibitor is
 available and willing to take the spot of the exhibitor. If, because of
 storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is
 impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will
 be made.

CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES before the stated closing date must
 be made in writing or by e- mail to the Test Secretary, and must be
 received by the secretary prior to the stated closing time.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE. Notification must be
 made to the Test Secretary prior to drawing for tracks. Such bitch(s)
 will run only after all other dogs have run and must be kept away
 from the immediate vicinity of the test prior to running.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, ie., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.
